Outdoor Activity: The Shepherds

Items Needed:

• 1 Brown Coat or A Piece of Brown Material (large enough to wrap around one child)

Instructions:

- Choose three children to be the "shepherds" and one child to be the "wolf."
- The "wolf" will wrap the brown material around himself or herself.
- The rest of the children are the "sheep."
- The "shepherds" need to guide the sheep to fresh water and grassy fields, while watching out for the "wolf."
- If the "sheep" see the "wolf," they will start making worried sheep sounds to call out to their "shepherd" about the danger.
- When the "wolf" gets close to the "sheep," the "shepherds" will get rid of the wolf by tagging him or her.
- When the "wolf" tags one of the "sheep," they are to go to a designated area for "lost sheep."
- When the "wolf" tags one of the "sheep," that sheep will go to a designated area for "lost sheep."
- When the "wolf" tags three "sheep," talk about how tough it is to be a shepherd, then choose four different children to be the "wolf" and the "shepherds."
