

Craft: Scripture Scroll

Items Needed:

- General: Scissors, Pencils or Pens, and Crayons or Markers
- Per Child: 1/2 Sheet of Construction Paper and 2 Craft Sticks

Instructions:

- Tell the children they will create a scroll on which they will write some special Bible verses.
- Explain that a scroll was used a long time ago to write things on, like we do with books now.
- Give each child 1/2 sheet of construction paper and two craft sticks.
- Have the children glue one craft stick on the top and one craft stick on the bottom of the construction paper.
- Tell them to write a Bible verse on their scroll (construction paper). Use this verse or sample verses below: 2 Timothy 3:16 (NIV) "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness."
- They can decorate the craft sticks and the construction paper to make their scrolls beautiful.

Sample Verses:

John 3:16, Matthew 28:19-20, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18, Deuteronomy 10:12-14, Matthew 22:34-40, Romans 10:17, or 2 Corinthians 5:7
